CCTMP - Coastal Communities Transportation Master Plan

Coastal Communities comprise the cities of Miami Beach, Aventura, Sunny Isles Beach, North Bay Village, and the towns of Bay Harbor Islands, Bal Harbour, Surfside, and Golden Beach. The Coastal Communities Transportation Master Plan (CCTMP) Technical Steering Committee is a group of city officials, planners, and residents working with the Corradino Consulting Group to study ways of addressing the area's growing vehicular problems.

CITT - Citizens Independent Transportation Trust:

The Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is the 15-member body created to oversee the People's Transportation Plan funded with the half-percent sales surtax.

TPC - Transport Planning Council

The Transportation Planning Council, or TPC, has ultimate responsibility for the technical adequacy of the MPO programs that are presented to the Governing Board for approval and adoption. It is chaired by the MPO Director and members are directors of county, and various municipal, departments involved in the transportation planning process.

The TPC relies on the LRTP Steering Committee, TIP Development Committee, TPTAC, and the UPWP Development Committee, and also establishes inter-agency task forces and special committees to ensure coordination of important concerns as needs arise. Meetings are held monthly and are open to the public.
